

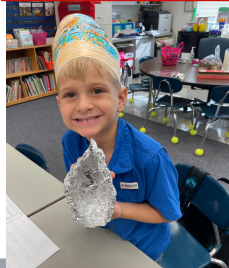
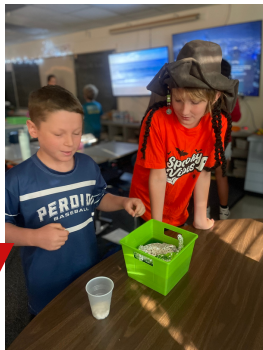

From the Principal's Desk



One of our goals for this year is to improve our daily attendance rate. This goal is not only school implemented, but is a district initiative, as well. We are tracking our data weekly. Our average daily attendance rate for September is 94.8%. Our goal is 95%, so we are right on track!

Starting in kindergarten, students can fall behind if they miss just a day or two days every few weeks. When a child misses 2 days a month, it adds up to 20 days that school year - the child will miss around 30 hours of math and 60 hours of reading/writing over the school year.
