- 1.0 credit Physical Education to include Personal Fitness
- 1 credit Fine/Performing Arts or Practical Art substitute
- 7.5 Credits Elective

Must have cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher

NOT request ROTC.

Must pass 10th grade Reading BEST and Algebra I exam or earn concordant scores!
