FALL 2024 EXAM ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

ACCOMMODATIONS:

 Students with extra-time, test format, or test location accommodations should develop a plan directly with the classroom teacher at least 24 hours prior to the start of the assessment so that we can ensure the best testing experience.

ATTENDANCE:

- Students are expected to be present for 100% of their scheduled exams.
- Check-outs will NOT be permitted during an exam period.
- Parents/guardians will be required to wait until the exam period is over for check-outs, regardless if the student has finished their exam.
- Check-outs on exam days will be EMERGENCY ONLY during break/transition times.

BEHAVIOR:

 Students who violate the technology policy or disciplinary expectations for exams could earn a 0% for the exam and are additionally subject to disciplinary consequences.

EXAM REQUIREMENT:

- o Students are REQUIRED to take semester exams to earn course credit.
- Semester exams will count for 20% of the final semester grade.
- Failure to complete semester exams will result in a student earning an I-incomplete for both the exam grade and the full semester average until the exam is completed. This is calculated as an F in the GPA calculation.
- Missing exams can impact GPA, academic standing, and possibly graduation status.

MAKE-UP POLICY:

- NO exams will be given early, off campus, or remotely.
- Students are expected to be present for 100% of their scheduled exams.
- Missing exams can impact GPA, academic standing, and possibly graduation status.
- In the event of unplanned sickness or emergency, students or guardians should schedule time to take make-up or missed exams directly with the classroom teacher after school hours Dec 18-20, 2024 or on January 6, 2025.

STUDENT RELEASE:

- Students will not be permitted to remain on campus after the release time each day except for officially sanctioned school events/activities or scheduled makeup exams.
- All students remaining on campus after the release time must be monitored by a faculty or staff member for 100% supervision while on campus.
