Stadium Policies

Tate Aggie Football is excited to welcome you to Carl Madison Field at Pete Gindl Stadium. The health, safety, and security of our fans, players, and staff is the top priority. We appreciate your continued cooperation in adhering to all policies while joining us for an exciting football season.

Alcohol, Tobacco, and Drugs

These items are strictly prohibited within the stadium and the entire Tate Campus.

Smoking Policy

Tate High School and Escambia County Public Schools is a smoke free facility. Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the campus. This includes but not limited to cigarettes, vapor cigarettes, and electronic cigarettes.

Large Bags

No book bags, laptop bags, and duffle bags will be allowed to enter the stadium. Only single compartment open top bags will be allowed into the stadium.

Blankets

Blankets are allowed into the stadium during football games. Football fans could be asked to shake the blacket as they enter the stadium

Children

All children entering the stadium will need to have a valid ticket for admission. Elementary Student tickets are for Kindergarten through 5th grade. All children/minors will be monitored by their parents/guardian while in the stadium.

No children younger than 9th grade will be admitted to the stadium without a parent/guardian in attendance.

Fan Code of Conduct Policy

All spectators while attending sporting events at Tate High School should adhere to all federal, state, and local laws. We are confident that all fans will share in the spirit of supporting the team, and demonstrating sportsmanship. Our image as Aggies is shaped by the players, coaches, parents, employees, and fans as well.
