Career Education Academies	<ul> <li>Career Academy Admission only during 8th and 9th grade via career academy application.</li> <li>All courses will be taken in progression.</li> <li>Students must maintain the following requirements:         <ul> <li>All students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 ("C" average).</li> <li>All students must have no recurring or major office discipline referrals that require extended suspension.</li> <li>All students must have no serious attendance issues.</li> <li>10 or less days per year.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Career & Technical Education Courses	<ul> <li>All courses are taken in progression according to the course code directory. Please do not allow students to jump around with the course sequence.</li> <li>Advanced Placement Courses (AP Computer Science)         <ul> <li>ELA FAST 4, 5</li> <li>ELA FAST 3 with ≥80% in past Business Education Courses</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Physical Education	<ul> <li>Students will follow Tate High School PE Progression Plan.</li> <li>Students can only take one credit of PE per school year.</li> <li>Enrollment in Athletic PE's requires a coach's signature.</li> </ul>
Music	Follow course progression based on teacher recommendations.
Army ROTC	<ul> <li>Complete courses in progression.</li> <li>Students must follow military uniform and grooming standards.</li> </ul>
