High School Credit Requirements for Graduation. Student must take and pass 24 credits:

- 4 Credits— English
- 4 Credits— Math, to include: Algebra 1 (EOC) or equivalent and Geometry (EOC)
- 3 Credits— Science, to include: Biology (EOC—30%)
- 3.5 credits— Social Studies, to include: World History, US History (EOC—30%), US Government, Economics, Personal Financial Literacy
- 1.0 credit — Physical Education to include Personal Fitness
- 1 credit— Fine/Performing Arts or Practical Art substitute
- 7.5 Credits— Elective
- Must have cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Must pass 10th grade Reading BEST and Algebra I exam or earn concordant scores!
