Course Offerings

Freshman:

CJ Operations I examines the American criminal justice system and its theory, best practices, courts, jails, and the juvenile justice system. Career opportunities, employability skills, and the development of basic interpersonal and communication skills related to the criminal justice field are presented.

Sophomore:

CJ Operations II provides the various academic and practical skills required of today's law enforcement officer. The course examines and identifies the essential elements related to the management, patrol operations, and community involvement of today's law enforcement agencies.

This program includes a combination of academic studies, research projects, and hands-on practical skill development that enable the student to obtain a greater understanding of the criminal justice profession.



Students will have the opportunity to participate with the Florida Public Service Association (FPSA), which will provide leadership and skill competitions against other chapters across the state of Florida.



Course Offerings

Junior:

CJ Operations III introduces the students to the specialized practical skills within the criminal justice system related to criminal investigations, forensic science, and crime scene investigation.

Senior:

911 Public Safety

Telecommunicator provides students with knowledge of the 911 call taker and dispatch professions and prepares students to take the Department of Health 911 Public Safety Telecommunicator (PST) state certification. Additionally, students learn about Open Source/Social Media investigation, and technology used in criminal justice.
