In 2007, the Worcester family, along with veterans, and others who had helped with their annual Christmas wreath ceremony in Arlington, formed Wreaths Across America™, to continue and expand this effort, and support other groups around the country who wanted to do the same. This nonprofit organization continues the Arlington tradition as part of its mission to Remember, Honor and teach. Our annual pilgrimage from Harrington, Maine to Arlington National Cemetery is known as the world's largest veteran's parade, stopping at schools, monuments, veteran's homes and communities all along the way to remind people how important it is to remember, honor and teach.

In 2023, Wreaths Across America and our national network of volunteers laid over 1.8 million memorial wreaths at nearly 1440 locations in the United States and beyond. Here in Pensacola, local High School Key Clubs, supported by Kiwanis, along with 37 other local groups, placed over 25,000 wreaths on the graves of veterans at Barrancas National Cemetery. Our ultimate goal is to **BLANKET BARRANCAS** in wreaths, ensuring that every one of the over 49,000 veterans graves and markers are honored and remembered for their service and sacrifice.

Help Pensacola achieve that goal by sponsoring one or more wreaths to honor and remember our veterans for their service.

The schedule to lay wreaths and arrangements for access are being worked out and will be published as soon as they are available. Wreath laying ceremonies are currently scheduled to begin at 0900 at Barrancas National Cemetery, on Saturday, December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
