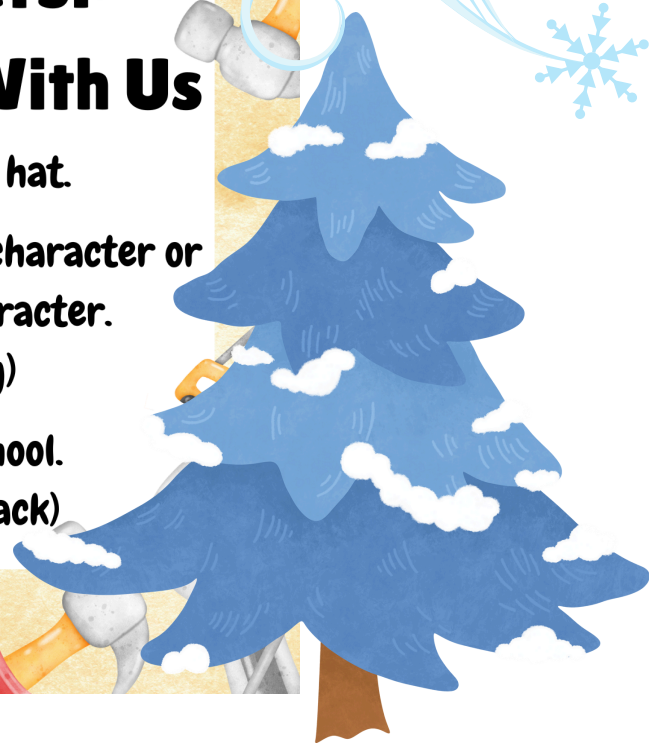
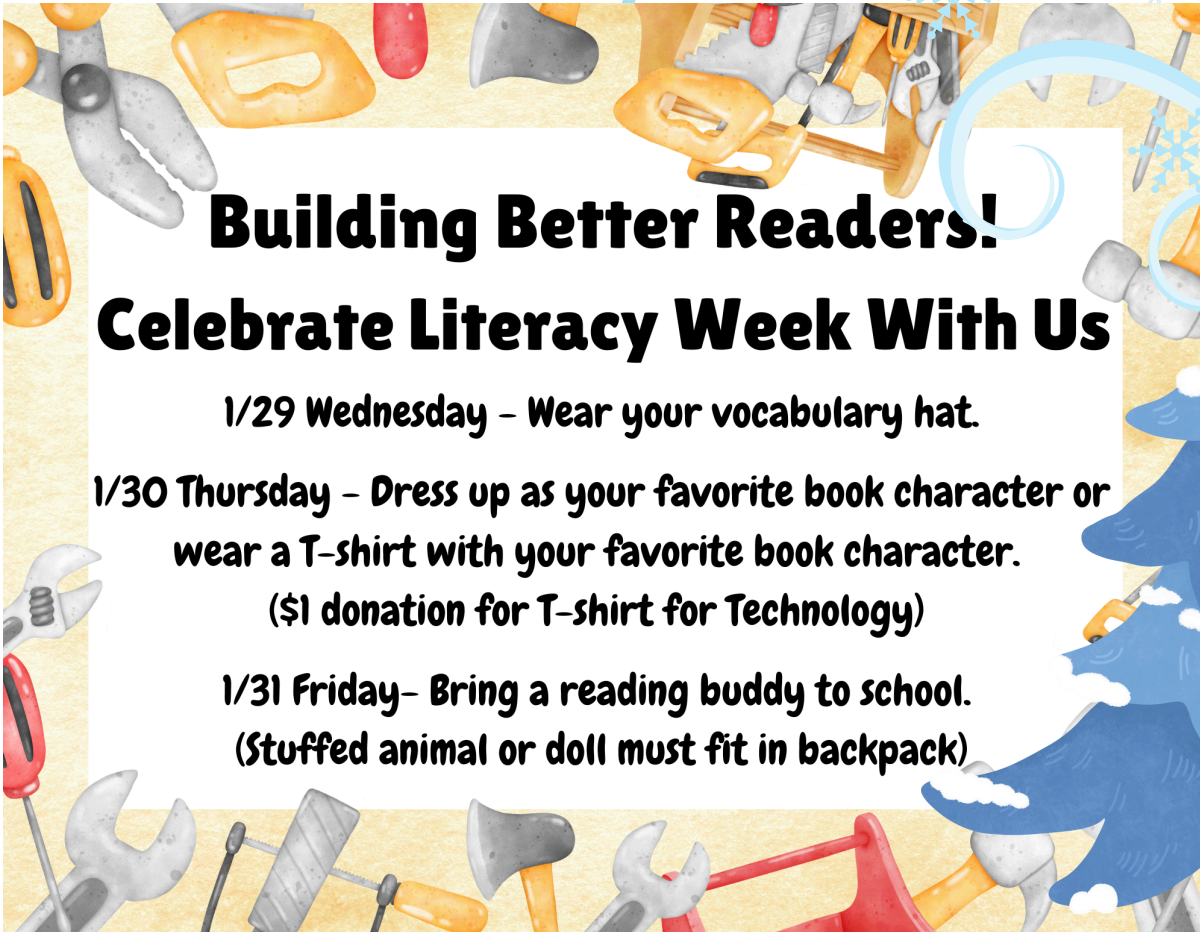
1/29 Wednesday - Wear your vocabulary hat.

(Stuffed animal or doll must fit in backpack)



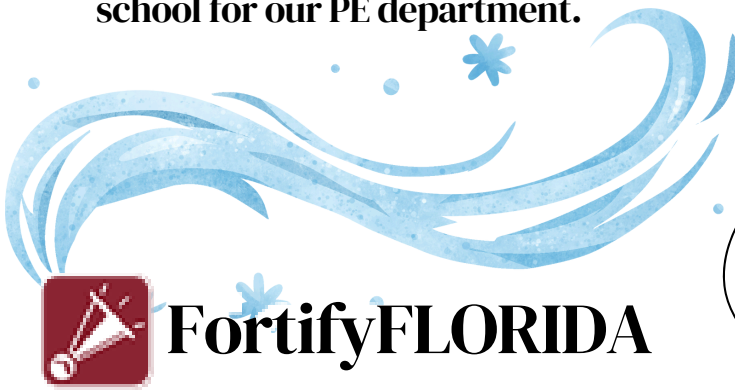
Don't Forget you \$1 !!!!
